Application Process

This application is to express your interest in joining the Southeast Regional Institute on Deafness (SERID) 2023 Conference Interpreting team in Charlotte NC, October 26th-29th. There will be limited interpreting needs on October 26th and 29th. October 27th and 28th will be the bulk of interpreting needs.

Hearing interpreters on the team will be required to have a Full NC Interpreting license, or if coming from out of state must be eligible for a Full License and submit a short-term interpreting registration form through the SERID Interpreter Coordinator for submission to the NCITLB.

Deaf interpreters will be required to have or be eligible for a NC interpreting license, but the Full license requirement will be waived given the limited ability for those interpreters to test for certification and receive results.
